Justice for Children (JFC) is a nationally renowned 501(c)(3) non-profit charity with headquarters in Houston, Texas and offices in Washington, D.C. Founded in 1987 by Randy Burton, a former Chief Prosecutor of the Family Offenses Section of the Harris County (Texas) District Attorney's office and a group of concerned citizens, JFC advocates for abused and neglected children caught in systemic failures. JFC is dedicated to ensuring the meaningful and informed application of the law for their protection. To that end, JFC works to develop and implement collaborative solutions to entrenched social and legal problems impacting the quality of our children's lives. JFC's mission is to protect these children from further abuse and to defend each child's right to grow up in a safe and loving environment.

PROTECT is committed to building a powerful, nonpartisan force for the protection of children from abuse, exploitation and neglect. After two years of hard work and struggle, the PROTECT Our Children Act was signed into law on October 13, 2008.
